Chip the Star

A Gnarwhal Crochet pattern to make cute amigurumi stars! ~



You need:

- 3mm hook
- Yarn needle
- 6mm safety eyes
- Black thread for the mouth

Round 1: make 5 single crochet in a magic ring (5)

[sc 5 in mr] (5)



Round 3: (make 1 single crochet in the next stitch, make 3 single crochet in the next stitch) (20)

[(sc, 2inc in next st) x5] (20)



Round 2: make 2 single crochet in every stitch (10)

[inc x5] (10)



Round 4: slip stitch in the first stitch from the previous round, (single crochet in the next stitch, then in the next stitch make a half double crochet, double crochet, half double crochet. Single crochet in the next stitch, slip stitch in the next stitch) x5.

You now have 5 little "arms". You make the last slip stitch in the first slip stitch of the round. Cut yarn and pull through.

[slst in next st, (sc in next st, hdc, dc, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slst in next st) x5]



Face tip: add the eyes in the stitches marked in the image below. These are the stitches where you made the 3sc clusters in!



Make another star without the face. Don't cut off the tail too short, leave about 30 centimetres to attach to the other one.

To assemble: put the insides of the stars together and whip stitch around. After you've attached 3 of the legs, start stuffing. Keep stuffing while you stitch the sides together.

Fasten off the thread and your star is done!
