

the perfect pear



With this pattern, you can create adorable pear plushies!

This free pattern was created and distributed by Julie van der Staak, Gnarwhal Crochet

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Before you start:

This pattern was made using the *amigurumi* method, meaning you don't close your round but instead continue working in a spiral.

This pattern uses the magic ring, but you can also chain 2 and work the stitches in the 2nd chain from the hook instead.

I used 2 threads of scrap yarn, a thin cotton thread and a stonewashed cotton/acrylic thread. You can use any kind of yarn, as long as you use the proper hook to obtain gauge!

You'll need:

- 3,5mm hook or hook needed to obtain gauge
- double thread of cotton yarn, or whatever yarn you like
- 8mm safety eyes
- a little bit of pink and black yarn to embroider the facial details
- about 3 yards of brown yarn for the stem
- stuffing
- a yarn needle

Abbreviations

- sc = single crochet
- slst = slip stitch
- ch = chain
- inc = increase
- dec = decrease

Pear body, starting from the bottom

- 1: make 6 sc in a magic ring
- 2: inc x 6 (12)
- 3: (sc, inc) x 6 (18)
- 4: (sc 2, inc) x 6 (24)
- 5: (sc 3, inc) x 6 (30)
- 6 – 10: sc around (30)
- 11: (sc, dec) x 10 (20)



Now attach the safety eyes between rounds 7 and 8, with 4 empty stitches in-between. Embroider the mouth and cheeks, using the above picture as a guide.

- 12 – 14: sc around (20)
- 15: (sc 2, dec) x 5 (15)
- 16 – 19: sc around (15)

Start stuffing the body, keep stuffing while you work.

- 20: (sc 3, dec) x 3 (12)
- 21: sc around (12)
- 22: dec x 6

Fasten off.

Stem, in brown:

Ch 6, in the 2nd chain from the hook make a slst, slst in each of the next 4 chains, fasten off.

Attach the stem to the top of the pear. I advise you to use a somewhat sharp needle!
